May 8th, 2024 CWC Meeting Minutes

<u>Secretary's Report:</u> Secretary Joni Singer reported the April 8th 2024 meeting minutes were sent out in the May Muffler newsletter and posted on the

Old Business: Club Grounds Use: Tom reminded everyone that to reserve the clubhouse, members should contact Vice President Ken Brekke. Jukebox Repairs- President Tom Woltman asked for suggestions on what to do with the jukebox now that it has been determined repair costs would be excessive. Should we leave it in the clubhouse or discard it? Members brought forward ideas including donating it for the Reunion auction.
