
Executive Director of MAFFI, John Marshall and his team of elves have just finished decorating the museum for the holidays. The Parts Department in the museum is looking pretty festive. Meanwhile outdoors the trusses are up on the expansion. The walls for the expansion are expected to up the week of November 18th --- so long as the weather cooperates. You can actually watch the construction if you go to maffi.org and click on the Camera icon, and then click on Expansion.

And right around December 23, the back wall of the museum will need to be opened up to connect the existing building and the expansion. This means moving all the displays at the back of the museum and covering all the museum artifacts with plastic. During this phase of the construction, the museum will be closed for safety reasons. (The closure is just temporary, so call ahead if you plan to visit in December or January to be certain the museum is back open).

As it should be: Model A'ers helping other Model A'ers!

Precursor to story below: New member Jeff Slager from Manitowoc contacted me about his ill functioning car. I contacted Eric Haban, our 2025 WI Rapids Reunion Chair and also a Manitowoc resident if he could stop over and help out. Eric is still a "youngster" and working full-time, but his dad, Erwin, also a Model A'er rendered aid. Here's the feedback I got along with a picture of a very happy new Nickle A member, Jeff Slager!

The other day I spent 4 hours with new Nickle A member, Jeff Slager working on his father's Model A. We conducted a compression test, all good, adjusted the timing to #1 TDC, disassembled the distributor's internals for cleaning, and replaced the wire connecting the upper and lower plates due to poor connections.

We also installed new points and a condenser, which Jeff had, adjusted the point gap, and set the timing. He had a new coil installed already. When finished, we had a great spark, maybe 3/8-1/2". He had newer plugs in. We looked them over when we pulled them for the compression test. They were all running rich. We talked about the GAV adjustments, and he had been way too rich. Then, I talked about the spark advance and how to use that. He had put an additional fuel filter installed in the line, so for obvious reasons we pulled that back out. He had a new fuel shutoff valve, new fuel line inside, and a new glass sediment bowl so he could monitor the fuel. We pulled and tore down, cleaned, and reassembled the Tillotson carburetor with a new gasket set. The float valve needed a thicker gasket to level out the float.

We fired up the car, and it runs nicely, better than Jeff can ever remember he says. There is a bad leaky connection between the exhaust pipe and the manifold. Jeff's making a list of materials and parts from Snyder's, which includes 100% all new wiring front to back. Jeff is very happy about today.
