



A Little Food For Thought



Every car sold must be serviced. The volume of this after service is tremendous. The big Oil Companies have not been slow in realizing this and acting accordingly. They are alert to the big profits to be had. Is it any wonder then that they buy up some of the choicest pieces of property in cities and towns all over the country and spend millions of dollars in setting up the luxurious filling and service stations that greet one's eyes wherever one may go.

Every Ford Dealer should go after his share of the business which rightfully belongs in his service station. Remember the big Mail Order Houses took away volume business from many smaller concerns. Next the Drug Stores — if they can still be so called — began stocking articles and lines entirely foreign to drugs and medicines until today one may go in any drug store and purchase practically everything. In fact the modern drug store looks more like a Mail Order House than a Mail Order House itself.

Just as the Mail Order Houses and Drug Stores have cut in on the business of other concerns and driven more and more of the smaller houses to the wall, so the big Oil Companies today are cashing in on the profits which

modern Lubrication brings in. Many Service Stations, unless they fortify themselves against this ever growing competition, will in turn find themselves crowded to the wall and eventually wiped out of the picture.

Obsolete equipment should be replaced with new and up-todate pieces. Do away with the dirty and dangerous pits and other inadequate and space wasting devices and install a battery or Hydraulic Lifts. Not only can cars be lubricated better and quicker on a Lift but cars can be thoroughly washed. That means under the chassis and inside the wheels, places seldom if ever reached in wash jobs handled in the old fashioned way. Also mechanics are enabled at the same time to carefully inspect the car while it is on the Lift, such as inspection of wheel bearings, spindle bolts, hub bolts, steering gear, etc. and the car owner advised of any needed repairs, which means, aside from the additional repair business such service would bring in, the building up of customer confidence without which no business can succeed.



nut installed. Scribe a line across the end of the bolt before assembly to help "line up" the castle nut for that darn #%\$@^&%&* cotter pin.
